Margaret Jones Library - The library is a wonderful resource for children. The library has computers and a summer reading program available for children of all ages. For more information please contact the library directly at 229-776-2096. The library is located at 205 E. Pope Street, Sylvester, GA 31791. REAC stands for Real Estate Assessment Center. REAC is a program within HUD. A REAC inspection is used by HUD to ensure housing is safe, decent and affordable; with the goal to restore the public's trust by identifying fraud, abuse and waste of HUD resources.

REAC inspections are helping improve the quality of HUD housing throughout the nation.

In preparation for this inspection the SHA staff has been hard at working ensuring all units comply with REAC standards.

During the inspection residents should be aware that staff will be checking

the properties. Some of the things staff will be checking for is blocked exits, inoperative smoke detectors, leaks, air quality, exposed wires and tripping hazards.

If you have any questions or concerns about the inspections, please reach out to your AMP Manager. In the fall of 2019 Sylvester Housing Authority was awarded a CHIP grant in the amount of \$300,000. CHIP stands for Community Home Investment Program. The purpose of this grant is to provide safe, decent and affordable housing in Georgia by granting funds to city and county governments, public housing authorities and other agencies. These funds are put towards rehabilitating owner-occupied homes or building/renovating affordable single-family homes which are then sold to eligible homebuyers.

Grant

Funding for the CHIP grant comes from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development HOME Investment Partnership Program.

The SHA will be putting the CHIP grant funds toward the new construction of three single-family home. These homes will be built on a plot of land SHA already owns.

There will be a public hearing on March 23, 2020 from 4:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. at 411 N Jefferson Street, Sylvester Georgia Board Room. Please attend the meeting if you would like to learn more about the home buying process, understand why your credit is important, determine if buying a home is right for you, gain access to attend a home buyer educational class.

#### RAB stands for Resident Advisory Board

The main role of the RAB is to make recommendations in the development of the Public Housing Authority (PHA) plan.

The RAB provides SHA and residents with a forum for sharing information about the SHA. Membership is made up of individuals who reflect and represent the residents of the Sylvester Housing Authority. The role of members is to assist Sylvester Housing Authority with the development of the PHA plan. Participating in the board in beneficial to both the SHA and residents because it gives residents the opportunity to voice their concerns, needs and wants. SHA gains firsthand knowledge from residents on improvements needed throughout the facilities. This information can be very beneficial when the SHA is budgeting priorities and improvements.

We are actively looking for members. This board is open to all Sylvester Housing Authority residents. Serving on the RAB is completely voluntary. There is no term limit which means a resident can participate for as short or as long as they like. The only requirement is they are a current SHA resident. Participation usually involves a quarterly meeting, held during the early afternoon at the main office located on 411 N. Jefferson, Sylvester, GA 31791.
